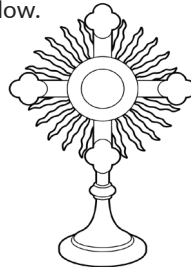
On the 18th of every month, we celebrate a Mass in remembrance of Mother Margherita’s passing!

Golden Heart Newsletter

“One day Jesus told me that I should be His daisy, with white petals and a little golden heart. The center of the daisy, which is the golden button, means Love; the white petals, purity, simplicity, and humility.”
(Venerable Mother Margherita, 1923)

A difficult childhood that made her grow in trust and love for God.

Mother Margherita lived between the 19th and 20th centuries (she was born on November 19, 1879, and died on June 18, 1974), during a complex historical period that included World War I, World War II, and the Second Vatican Council. In the midst of all this, she was a true sign of God’s love amid the many difficulties she faced! Today, we too experience a deep need for peace in the world and in the Church, but her example of trust and love for God can help us overcome everything.

Her father died when she was just six years old, and shortly after, her mother sent her to a boarding school for orphaned girls. Her mother rarely visited her there, and in the midst of this pain, her heart grew closer and closer to the Lord. She found in Him and in the Virgin Mary her greatest comfort and strength.

made it difficult for her to be accepted into religious life. But in the end, nothing could stop her from answering the call God had placed in her heart: at the age of 22, she joined the Daughters of the Cross in France. Nineteen years later, she left that congregation and entered a cloistered institute, the Passionist Nuns, which she also eventually left—because she could no longer resist the call the Lord was making to her: to found a new religious institute.

And so, after much prayer and discernment, on January 17, 1923, she founded the Oblate Sisters of Divine Love, where she beautifully combined a life of Eucharistic adoration and reparation with an apostolic mission of leading others to know the Lord.

Ten days after her birth in Partinico, Italy, she was baptized with the name Diomira Ludovica Romana (she loved her first name, Diomira, which means “look at God”).

From a young age, she felt a strong desire to consecrate her life to God, but she faced many obstacles in pursuing this vocation. Her mother opposed her decision, and a paternal uncle—an influential atheist politician in Italy—

Mother Margherita died almost at the age of 95, on June 18, 1974. After a life devoted to the love of God and the service of others, it was her intense prayer that sustained her, as her virtues were severely tested even through the slanders and sufferings she endured. She experienced pain, misunderstanding, and the loss of loved ones... Have you ever lived through something like this?

Ask her to help you! She was declared Venerable (the step before beatification) by Pope Francis on December 17, 2022, and her cause is currently awaiting approval of alleged miracles through her intercession.

Her example of patience and trust in God, who never abandoned her, remains today a sign of hope amid our struggles.

Testimonies of the Intercession of Venerable Mother Margherita Diomira

My paternal grandmother, Juana Moya Brenes, had been diagnosed with colon cancer. She was very close to me since she took care of me when I was a child. When I learned about her illness, I gave her a prayer card* of Mother Margherita, and my grandmother prayed the prayer with such faith that the next day she told my family she had decided not to undergo the surgery she had scheduled because "the little nun in black" on the prayer card had healed her.

My family convinced her that the operation was necessary, but to the glory of God, on the day of the surgery the doctors found no colon cancer as previously diagnosed.

Venerable Madre Margherita Diomira

At the beginning of December 2024, a friend gave me a prayer card of Mother Margherita Diomira Crispi so that I could pray to her asking for her intercession for my daughter-in-law to become pregnant. My daughter-in-law has blocked fallopian tubes—80% blockage in one and 100% in the other. My son and daughter-in-law were undergoing in vitro treatment.

Before December, I had been praying to God through the intercession of the Virgin Mary, that if it was God's will, she would conceive through that treatment, but if not, that they would have their family in another way. As soon as I received the prayer card, I gave it to my daughter-in-law (without asking if she would pray it or not), and I began to pray fervently to Venerable Diomira Crispi. Today, we received the happy news that she is pregnant naturally and that the baby will be born in August. I attribute this favor or miracle to God through the intercession of Mother Margherita and the Virgin of the Immaculate Conception.
